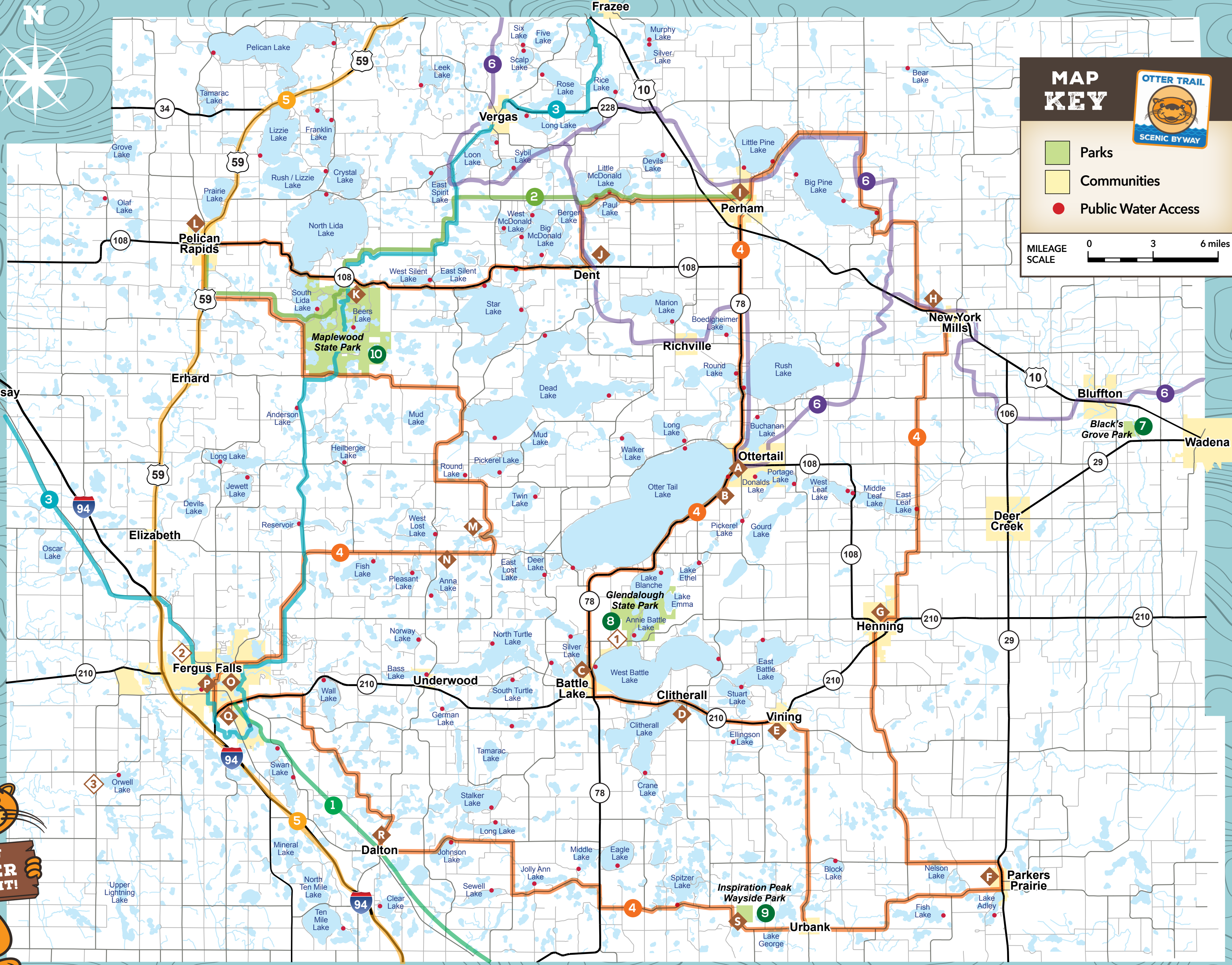
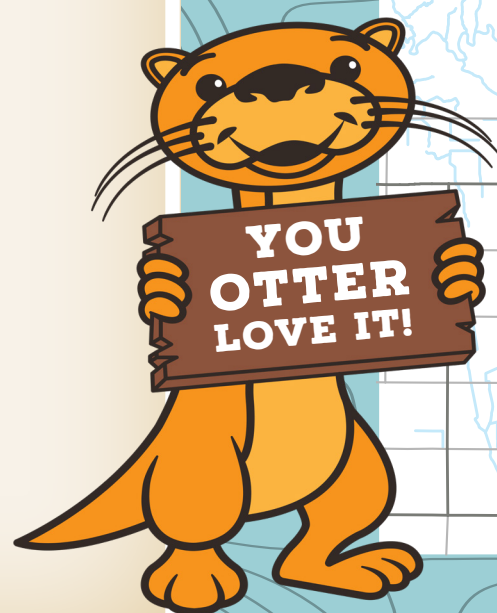


AREA TRAILS

- 1  **Central Lakes Trail**
is built on an abandoned Burlington Northern Railroad corridor and runs 55-miles from Osakis to Fergus Falls, MN.
- 2  **Heart of the Lakes Trail**
is a 32-mile long, multi-use recreational trail connecting the communities of Perham and Pelican Rapids via Maplewood State Park.
- 3  **North Country National Scenic Trail**
features a 10-mile segment through Fergus Falls. It offers scenic family-friendly hiking opportunities through prairies, woodlands, and neighborhoods.
- 4  **Otter Trail Scenic Byway**
a 150-mile loop through beautiful Otter Tail County, MN. Expanded route coming 2024.
- 5  **Pine to Prairie International Birding Trail**
Minnesota's first birding trail. This trail features 45 sites throughout Minnesota for viewing and photographing birds.
- 6  **Otter Trail Riders Snowmobile Club**
Promoting safe snowmobiling through training in Otter Tail Lakes Country. They maintain and groom 150 miles of trails.

PARK TRAILS

- 7  **Black's Grove Park**
near Wadena features a log picnic shelter, primitive restrooms, hiking, cross country skiing, horse trails and mountain biking.
- 8  **Glendalough State Park**
features 9-miles of hiking trails, 2-miles of mountain biking trails, and a paved bike trail during the summer. In the winter, spend the day snowshoeing or cross-country skiing on the 8-miles of groomed trails.
- 9  **Inspiration Peak Wayside Park**
has a quarter-mile winding hike to the summit which can be quite the workout. The view from the top is particularly impressive in the fall, but this wayside rest area offers a captivating view at any time of the year.
- 10  **Maplewood State Park**
has 25 miles of hiking and 20 miles of horse trails during the summer. During the winter, enjoy 5 miles of both- groomed and ungroomed back-country cross-country skiing, 21 miles of groomed snowmobile trails, and 1/2 mile of groomed snowshoeing trails.

Location: Halfway between Battle Lake and Perham at the intersection of State Highways 78 and 108.</p> <p>B Otter Tail Lake
Location: Approximately 13 miles south of Perham on the lake side of State Highway 78. Pull into the wayside rest area (not the public boat access) on the west side of the roadway facing Otter Tail Lake.</p> | <p>1 Side Trip #1: Glendalough State Park
Location: The park entrance is north off county Road 16, 1.8 miles east of State Highway 78.</p> <p>C Battle Lake
Location: The picnic/rest area on the west side of State Highway 78, at the foot of the Chief Wenonga roadside statue.</p> <p>D Clitherall
Location: At the roadside pull off east of County Road 5 on the south side of State Highway 210.</p> | <p>E Vining Roadside Sculptures
Location: On the south side of State Highway 210 at the "foot" statue in downtown Vining.</p> <p>F Parkers Prairie
Location: Memorial Park at the intersection of HWY 29 and E Lake St across from Lake Adley.</p> <p>G Henning
Location: NE side of the Henning City Park, along Douglas Avenue (Hwy.108), just SE of the intersection of Douglas & Marshall Ave</p> | <p>H New York Mills: Regional Cultural Center/Finn Creek Open Air Museum
Location: Southeast of Perham at the intersection of U.S. Highway 10 and County Road 67.</p> <p>I Perham: Railroads and Industry
Location: E side of NP Park next to the Welcome To Perham Mural.</p> <p>J Dent
Location: At the intersection of State Highway 108 and County Road 35.</p> | <p>K Maplewood State Park
Location: East of Pelican Rapids on State Highway 108.</p> <p>L Pelican Rapids: The Immigrant Story
Location: The parking lot on the northeast corner of State Highways 59 and 108, facing Pelican Pete, the World's Largest Pelican.</p> <p>M Phelps Mill National Historic District
Location: On County Road 45, halfway between Fergus Falls and Pelican Rapids.</p> | <p>N Rural Schools
Location: At the southeast corner of the intersection of County Roads 35 and 1.</p> <p>O Fergus Falls: River City
Location: On the southeast corner of Friberg and Summit, at the river parking area.</p> <p>2 Side Trip #2: Fergus Falls: Otter Tail County Historical Museum
Location: 1110 West Lincoln Ave., Fergus Falls, MN 56537</p> | <p>3 Side Trip #3: Orwell Lake and Dam Wildlife Viewing Area
Location: Six miles southwest of Fergus Falls on County Road 15; the picnic area is on the east side of the roadway between County Roads 114 and 2.</p> <p>P Dams
Location: On Cascade Street, between Lincoln and Washington in downtown Fergus Falls.</p> | <p>O Prairie Wetlands Learning Center
Location: 602 State Highway 210 East, between I-94 and County Road 82 on the south side of 210 East.</p> <p>R Dalton
Location: The entrance to the Threshermen's Grounds is one block south of the junction of County Roads 35 and 12.</p> | <p>S Inspiration Peak Wayside Park
Location: The entrance is off County Road 38, two miles west of Urbank (follow signs).</p> |
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
